

reScript (v2.1) Guide for Prescribers

Welcome to reScript

This guide will show you screenshots of what reScript will look like and explain some of the features available.

1. Please enable the NZePS in your Practice Management System, for each prescriber

reScripts must be sent as an e-prescription from your PMS.

Sending e-prescriptions to a pharmacy via reScript is signature exempt for non-controlled drugs, as long as the e-prescription has the NZePS barcode.

If you are not already on NZePS (i.e., generating prescriptions with an NZePS barcode), please contact onlinehelpdesk@health.govt.nz

2. Then obtain your licence key and installation instructions for reScript and AppBar on another computer in your practice

Goto <https://drinfo.co.nz/downloads/rescript/> for the **license key and reScript installer**.

Please liaise with your IT Support Provider on how best to install reScript and the AppBar.

The version in the video is the previous version of reScript so for updated screenshots see below.

Once reScript is installed:

First time using, or if a locum doctor is using your computer, please go to the SETTINGS icon (small cog above the reScript logo, top right):



1. Enter the practice **software key** (once only, same key for all prescribers within the practice)
2. Add/Edit the **prescribers** details (e.g., Doctors name and NZMC)
3. Select the **physical printer** to be the physical printer when a paper printed copy is required (e.g., for controlled drugs)

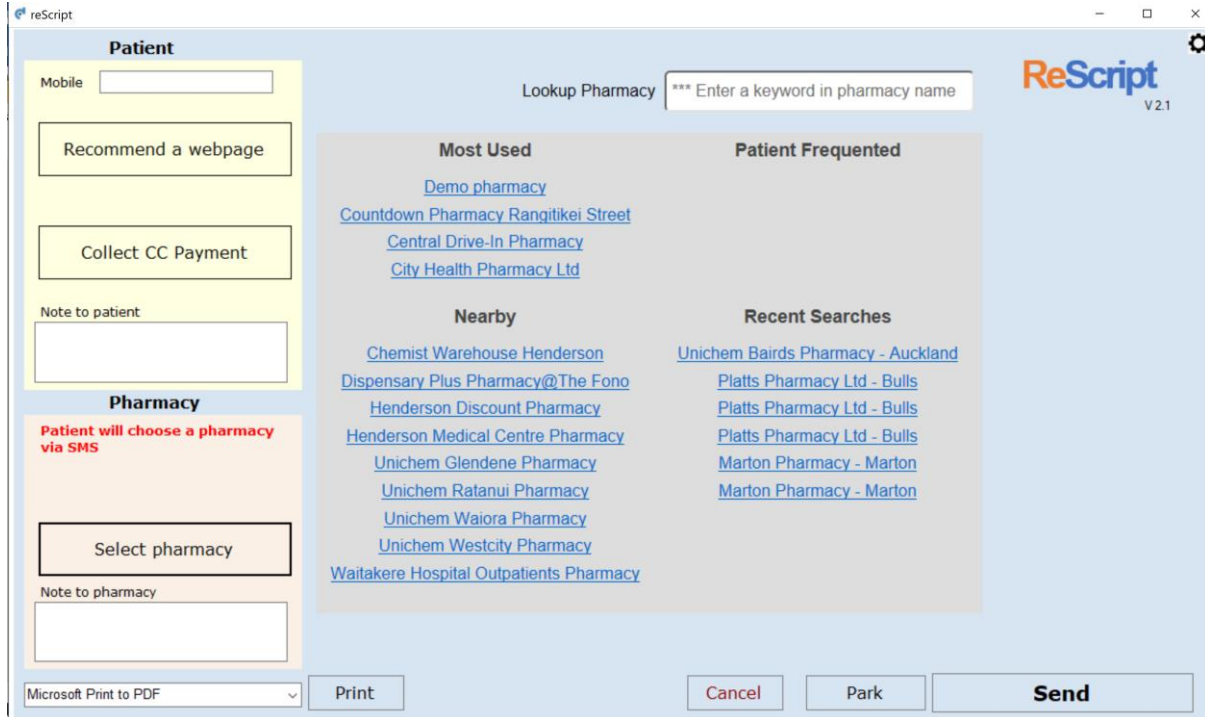

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To send an e-prescription to a pharmacy of the patients choice:

Generate the **e-prescription** as normal in your **Practice Management System**.

When **reScript** is selected as the printer, the reScript window will pop up.




Pharmacy selection





	<p>If the prescriber knows the pharmacy that the patient wants their e-prescription sent to, click SELECT PHARMACY and click on the pharmacy name. (If mistakenly chosen you can CHANGE PHARMACY before it is sent)</p> <p>If no pharmacy is selected, the mobile number populated in the patient section will receive a text message and ask the patient to choose a pharmacy.</p> <p>The prescriber can also add a note to the pharmacy</p>
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Most used	Displays the pharmacies most frequently used by the prescriber
Patient frequented	Displays the pharmacies which have been used by the patient to pick up dispensed medications
Nearby	Displays pharmacies close to the practice
Recent searches	Displays the pharmacies the prescriber has recently searched
Look up pharmacy	Enables the prescriber to look up any pharmacy nationwide

Patient communication

	<p>For the patient to receive a notification, there must be a mobile phone number entered. After the first time, the patient has the option to provide an email address for future notifications. If the patient does not have a mobile number, the practice will need to contact the patient to notify them of which pharmacy their prescription has been sent to.</p> <p>Recommend a web page – takes the prescriber to the internet with several helpful links, or to self-search. Click Recommend this link in the notification message to the patient.</p> <p>Collect CC Payment – Allows you to request online payment from the patient via their credit card (more details below).</p> <p>The prescriber has the option to add a message for the patient by typing in the Note to patient field.</p>
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Sending to pharmacy via reScript

	
	<p>To send the prescription to the selected pharmacy (or to patient to choose) please click on SEND</p>
	<p>If a nurse is preparing the prescription for the doctor, the reScripts can be held in to PARK. The doctor then picks up the parked reScripts from their AppBar and approves (or declines). Any changes to the prescription will need to be made in the PMS and re-sent to reScript so the PMS remains the true record.</p>
	<p>To cancel the reScript click on CANCEL.</p>

That's it! Simple and easy to use.

Remember to also install the AppBar on each computer

The practice can track and monitor all reScripts via your practice AppBar.

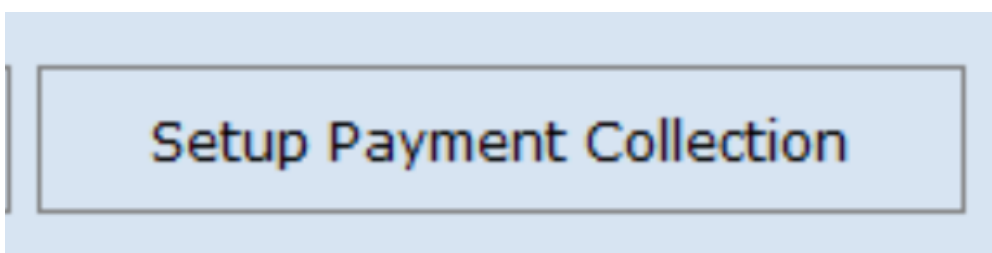
We recommend installing AppBar on the computers of:

- Front desk / reception

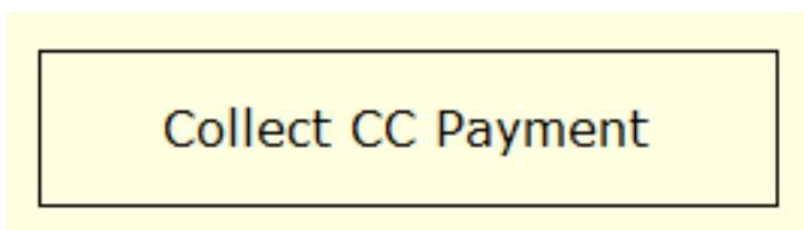
Collecting payment from patient via credit card

Collecting payment from patients via **rePay** is an optional service for which there is a small fee per transaction. The fees will be displayed as you enter the amount. Please ensure you add an email address for your daily record of payments to be sent to. Then collate these daily reScript service receipts and then send us an invoice us for the totals when required.

To set up the payment collection, go to the SETTINGS cog and click on **Set Up Payment Collection**



To request payment from a patient, click on **Collect CC payment**
