Purpose of Position:

The Casual Outreach Vaccinator provides assistance to the EBPHA to achieve BOPDHB health targets for immunisation by:

- Linking with local Outreach Administrator to receive referrals of children requiring vaccination
- Providing information and support to Whanau on immunisation issues
- Providing vaccinations to children with parental consent in the community environment.

Key Focus Areas:	To provide vaccinations to children referred by NIR living within the Eastern Bay of Plenty. Vaccinations are to be delivered generally to children under 6 years of age
Role Objectives:	To provide back up support and relief cover for the OIS vaccinator To work collegially with OIS Administrator and members of the Regional Childhood Immunisation team To ensure all documentation requirements are completed in a timely manner as per EBPHA protocols.
